It is expected that the Security Risk Controller will proactively use CCTV Surveillance equipment, check delivery paperwork and record the weight of lorries arriving and leaving the site, manage access control, be an active player in the business's security, and actively participate in the creation of a secure environment in which client assets, information, and operations are protected.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Proactively identify, evaluate, and report security threats within the facility through the professional use of CCTV Surveillance equipment.
- Check delivery paperwork and record the weight of lorries arriving and leaving the site.
- Manage Access Control
- Be an active player in business security and participate in the creation of a secure environment in which client assets, information, reputation and operations are protected.
- Monitor CCTV cameras for access control, suspicious activity, pedestrian, and vehicular movements in and outside the facility.
- Log in to the CCTV register any faults/anomalies that will affect the business.
- Communicate any suspicious characters, vehicles, or items detected via cameras.
- Monitor guard alertness.
- Escalate incidents up the chain of command as soon as possible.
- Verify documentation.
- Visitor management.

Qualifications

- Minimum of KCSE Certificate with a grade of C and above
- Minimum of 2 years experience as a control room operator
- Experience using relevant technology and security equipment (e.g. CCTV, Computers, 2-way radio, and security software)
- Experience in reporting and emergency response planning
- Excellent knowledge of security protocols and procedures
- Proficient in MS Office and Google Suite
- A valid Certificate of Good Conduct, less than 1 year old date of issue
- An analytical mind with problem-solving skills
- Excellent organizational and multitasking abilities
